

- Asthma Findings
- Improved in the documentation of classification of asthma, f/u in giving flu shots, and AAPs
- Remained strong is use of ICS

BARNWELL

Asthma

- Aprima (EMR) developed a "Health Maintenance Alert" to identify patients who needed an updated Asthma Action Plan

EPSDT


- Nearly 100% of EPSDT had developmental screens completed and charted

BEAUFORT

- The addition of a new full time provider has significantly improved access
- 45% reduction in the need for providers to extend
- 18% reduction in the number of extended appointments per extended day


BEAUFORT

LITTLE RIVER

Nov. 24 2014

- Staff began using SEEK screenings at additional WCCs
- SEEK log updated to track **types of referrals**
- SEEK screening modified
 - Number the questions
 - Name of the parent/guardian & relationship to the patient
- Allowed practice to identify effectiveness of screening and refer positive screenings

LITTLE RIVER

- (Baseline) September 2014
 - 137 handouts given (if positive)
- October 2014
 - 93 -did not document specific positives
- November 2014
 - 154 -increase in screenings and specific positives noted
- September and October positives were not documented
- November positives
 - 3 related to home environment
 - 2 for food
 - 1 for Depression
 - 1 for spouse abuse
- Resources were given and referrals were made appropriately



MUSC

Patient Electronic Access

Epic MyChart

- Two-way communication
- Send requests electronically
- Refills and appointments
- Receive test/image results within 72 hours of their completion

MUSC

- Created a written care plan for transitions of patients as they "age out"
- Past medical history and problem list sections
- Referral to an adult provider based on the patient's preferred practice
- Option of a practitioner
